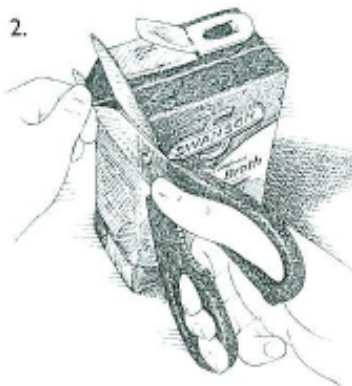
## Quick Pour

1. Open the container's plastic tab and peel off its seal.

2. Lift the opposite end's glued cardboard corner. Snip it off with a sharp pair of kitchen shears. Squeeze the box to open the slit, then pour from that end.
